

Dear players,

Thank you for your participation at the 4th FLT CUPRA Padel Championships.

We are pleased to inform you that the draws and schedules are already available and can be consulted through the following link:

All the schedules have been drawn up with regard to the already published composition calendar. Only inquiries regarding the times were taken into account as far as possible. Please note that due to the already made reservations of the Padel courts, no more changes can be allowed to the match schedules.

In this context, we would like to share some important information with you:

Point 1 – General Informations

Every team is composed by 2 men, 2 women or 1 men and 1 women (mixed).

- The group stages will take place from 26th of September to the 3th of October 2025.
 Please note that the matches will be played at CK Sportcenter (Kockelscheuer),
 Sport4Lux (Münsbach) or Bonnevoie (Tennis Club Bonnevoie).
- The courts have been pre-booked at the respective match times and the responsible will provide match balls.
- We kindly ask you to keep to the given playing times. In case of late unexcused arrival of a team, a W.O. will be given, according to the referee's criteria.

Point 2 – Play Mode at the group stages for the categories 100,200,300,400 and 500

- Each group consists normally of four (4) teams or, if there is no other option, group of five (5). However, the minimum of teams in a group is three (3) teams.
- The groups stage matches will be played to 9 games with silver point, and in case of a tie at 8-8, play a normal tiebreak up to 7 points.
- The groups will be sorted by:
 - 1) total of points;
 - 2) games difference;
 - 3) most games won;
 - 4) direct game:
 - Wins: 1 point. Lost: 0 points.
 - If two teams are still tied, a draw will decide the winner. The draw is carried out by the person responsible, in the presence of two players or witnesses.

- If the groups are uneven (e.g. 3 groups of four and 2 groups of three), in the groups of four, the matches in this group that were played against the bottom-ranked team will not be included in the count and will be excluded from the results.
- After the group stage, a main draw will be created for each of the aforementioned categories. The round of 16 (depending on the number of teams), quarterfinals, semifinals and finals will be played. The top two teams in each group will advance to the main draw. If there are not enough groups to complete main draw with the two group leaders, the best third-placed teams will be called in instead. These teams will be selected using the same criteria described above.

Point 3 -Play Mode Main Draw for the cat 100, 200, 300, 400 and 500

- The round of 16 (1/8 finals) will be played in the period before the ¼ finals.
- The quarter-finals will be played on the 11 of October at CK Sportcenter and S4L.
- The semi-finals and finals will be played on the 12 October at Sport4Lux (Münsbach).
- The main draw will be played in two sets of six games each, following the standard tiebreak format (at 6-6). Should it be necessary, the third set will be played in match tiebreak format (up to 10 with a two-point difference). In sets one and two, the games are played with silver point.
- The same criteria's as in the quarter-finals, will also be applied in the semi-finals.
- Each final is played best of two sets with advantage.

Point 4 -Play Mode for the cat 700

- A main draw will be set up for category 700.
- Each match in category 700 will be played in two winning sets until the final, with a possible third set being played in a match tie-break (up to ten with a two-point difference).
- In sets one and two, the game is played with silver point.
- The final is played in best of two (2) sets with advantage.

Point 5 -Balls at the group stages

- Two (2) new ball tubes in a group of four (4) or five (5) teams
- One (1) new ball tube in a group less than four (4) teams





Point 6 -Balls at the main draw

- One (1) new ball tube for each game in the main draw.
- In the final, new balls will be issued in the event of a third set.
- All the matches will be played with balls of the HEAD brand.

Point 7 - Important

- If a team makes a W.O. before the first match of the group stage has been played, the groups will be redrawn. This applies to groups of three in each category.
- If one team withdraws from the main draw in the first round, one lucky loser moves up.
- The main draw in category 700 will be redrawn if a seeded team reports a walk-over (WO) before the first match has begun.

Point 7 – Diverse

- The awards ceremony will be held after all the finals (Sunday afternoon).
- In addition to the prizes, there will be a raffle for the participating players. Only one registration will be allowed per player. The winners will be announced during the awards ceremony.
