

Application Guidelines for the Organization of the Finals of the 5th Luxembourg Padel Championship

The finals day of the Luxembourg Padel Championship is a key event dedicated to promoting and celebrating padel in Luxembourg. This document sets out the conditions and requirements for clubs wishing to submit their application to host this event, under the supervision of the Padel Commission of the Luxembourg Tennis Federation (FLT).

Event Information

Date of the finals: 10 October 2026

Match schedule: Established by the Padel Commission and the appointed referee.

Match balls: Provided by the Padel Commission.

Application Procedure and Submission Deadline

Interested clubs must submit their application by email. padel@flt.lu

to the Padel Commission no later than 23 March 2026

The selected organizing club will be announced by the FLT Padel Commission.

Application Criteria

- Minimum of two padel courts located at the same venue.
- Full compliance with the specifications described in this document.

Obligations of the Organizing Club

Courts :

- Provide at least two padel courts free of charge for all semi-final and final matches (full day).

- Ensure the courts are playable and in good condition (e.g., clean glass walls and properly maintained surfaces).
- Provide appropriate seating or viewing areas for spectators (e.g., stands, benches, chairs).
- Provide a bar or refreshment area offering drinks and food for spectators throughout the day.
- Provide scoreboards on the courts (can be supplied by the Padel Commission upon request).
- If possible, install a livestream on the main court (camera(s) provided by the Padel Commission).
- Display sponsor materials of the Padel Commission on the courts.
- Ensure matches take place under optimal conditions and that players are not disturbed (e.g., traffic around courts, noise from other activities).

Venue / Site Requirements :

- Display sponsor materials of the Padel Commission at the organizer's venue.
- Display club sponsors only if they do not compete with the Padel Commission sponsors and after prior approval.
- Provide changing rooms and showers for players.
- Provide a VIP area with catering (catering proposal must be submitted to the Padel Commission).
- Provide boards displaying match schedules and results on site.
- Provide a sound system with microphone for match and result announcements.
- Provide a designated area for the referee equipped with a table, chair, electricity and internet access.
- Provide a podium for the prize ceremony.
